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ITINERARY

Tuesday, Nov. 1 TRANSATLANTIC FLIGHT TO TEL AVIV

Today, we depart from the USA for Tel Aviv, Israel. Meals served in flight.

Wednesday, Nov. 2

ARRIVE IN ISRAEL

We arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport in Tel Aviv and are transferred to our hotel on the Mediterranean coast for check-in, dinner, and a good night's sleep.

Thursday, Nov. 3

CAESAREA MARITIMA, MOUNT CARMEL, MEGIDDO, NAZARETH (MOUNT PRECIPICE), CANA, SEA OF GALILEE

After our delicious buffet breakfast, we will stop at **Caesarea by the Sea** on the Mediterranean coastline. It was here that Cornelius the centurion and his household were saved and baptized (Acts 10), and it was also where Paul made his defense before Festus and King Agrippa prior to his final journey to Rome (Acts 25 - 26). We will continue to the top of **Mount Carmel**, where Elijah prayed down the fire from Heaven and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal (I Kings 18). Also on today's agenda is a visit to **Megiddo** overlooking the Valley of Armageddon (Rev. 16). Then, it is on to **Nazareth**, the boyhood home of our Lord (Lk. 2). We will stand on the **Mount Precipice**, where tradition says the locals attempted to throw Jesus off the cliff after preaching in their synagogue. We will pass through **Cana** where Jesus turned the water into wine on our way to the **Sea of Galilee** where we will check into our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Friday, Nov. 4

SEA OF GALILEE, BOAT RIDE, CHORAZIN, TEL DAN, CAESAREA PHILIPPI, GOLAN HEIGHTS

We begin our day with a beautiful **boat ride** across the **Sea of Galilee**. Then, we begin our journey north, stopping at the remains of **Chorazin**. Listed as a "city of woe," it was one of the cities cursed by our Lord. We continue north to **Tel Dan**, one of ancient Israel's boundary markers - "From Dan to Beersheba," and journey to **Caesarea Philippi**, where Peter proclaimed that Jesus was the Messiah. Travel through the **Golan Heights** and better understand their strategic importance to the security of Israel before returning to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Saturday, Nov. 5 CAPERNAUM, MOUNT OF BEATITUDES, TABGHA, JORDAN RIVER, JORDAN VALLEY, SODOM AND GOMORRAH, DEAD SEA

After enjoying an Israeli buffet breakfast, we will spend most of our day around the Sea of Galilee. We start the day with a drive along the shores of the lake, passing the area of **Magdala**, home of Mary Magdalene. Next, we travel to **Capernaum** and stand in the ruins of the synagogue built atop the remains of the one in which our Lord Jesus taught. Visit the **Mount of Beatitudes**, the traditional site where Jesus preached His Sermon on the Mount (Matt. 5-7), and stop at **Tabgha**, the site of the feeding of the 5,000 (Luke 9). After a fish lunch (included), we spend some time at the **Jordan River** for a time of spiritual blessing and then begin our journey south through the **Jordan Valley**. Visit the area of what is thought to be the ruins of biblical **Sodom and Gomorrah**. We arrive at our hotel on the **Dead Sea** for check in, dinner and overnight at the Dead Sea.

Sunday, Nov. 6 MOUNT OF OLIVES, PALM SUNDAY ROAD, GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE, BETHLEHEM

This morning, we check out of our hotel and drive through the Judean Wilderness to Jerusalem, the capital city of Israel. We can stand atop the Mount of Olives (Luke 19 & II Sam. 15) and visit the Site of the Ascension (Acts 1). Together we'll walk down Palm Sunday Road and take time to pray among the ancient olive trees in the Garden of Gethsemane (John 18). In Bethlehem, visit the cave where Jesus was born and the church that has been constructed on the site. Nearby, you will view Shepherds' Field, where the Good News was first heard. After a full day of sightseeing, we will enjoy dinner and overnight in our hotel in Jerusalem.

Monday, Nov. 7

UPPER ROOM, CAIAPHAS' HOUSE, POOL OF BETHESDA, GARDEN TOMB - GORDON'S CALVARY

Sing praises in the **Upper Room** (Luke 22), then go across the street to the remains of the House of the **High Priest Caiaphas** (John 18) and walk through some of the ancient rooms. Continue our journey through the **Old City** to the **Pool of Bethesda** (John 5), where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle. Finally, sense the agony of the Lord's crucifixion at **Gordon's Calvary** (Luke 23) and experience the exhilaration and reality of the resurrection at the **Garden Tomb**! After our final dinner in Israel, we motorcoach to the Tel Aviv airport to transfer for our return flight to the USA.


Tuesday, Nov. 8
